

On street parking

On street parking in this area is restricted and parking bays are marked where waiting is limited to two hours maximum between 8am and 6:30pm from Monday to Friday and a pay and display must be displayed. In Longport and St Martins Hill this restriction applies from Monday to Saturday. There are also a small number of parking bays where waiting is limited to 20 minutes at all times. On Sundays and outside these times parking is unrestricted except on yellow lines.

Your on street parking permit allows you to park in the marked bays without purchasing a ticket and without the two hour time restriction.

You cannot use your permit where waiting is limited to 20 minutes.

A resident may also purchase Daily Visitors Vouchers in advance for visitors, to enable them also to avoid time restrictions in the marked two hour bays. Visitors vouchers are purchased either in person or by post from the Canterbury City Council offices. However you must provide proof of your residency within the zone at the time of purchase.

NB Only 65 vouchers can be purchased at any one time.

Please read carefully the following notes:

- A permit may be issued for a motor vehicle (under 3.5 tonnes) or a motor cycle.
- The permit is issued in the registration of one vehicle only and must be clearly displayed in that vehicle's windscreen.
- The permit allows the vehicle to be parked in the designated bays within St Martins residents' parking zone as shown overleaf.
- The purchase of a permit does not guarantee the availability of a parking space, but will exempt the vehicle from the time restriction within the marked bay except the 20 minute bays.
- The purchase of a permit does not exempt the vehicle from yellow line restrictions.
- The permit will only be replaced in case of loss, destruction or through change of vehicle for which there is a £10 administration charge. This applies to the temporary use of courtesy cars.
- Only one permit can be issued per household unless availability exceeds demand.

Any contravention of the above will render the permit invalid and the permit will be withdrawn.

Conditions of use

- The permit must be displayed on the nearside of the vehicle windscreen ensuring that all of the details can be seen.
- The permit is only valid within designated parking bays in the zone indicated on the face of the permit. It does not entitle you to park outside your property or have preferential rights over another driver parked in a bay which you may wish to use.
- Your permit does not entitle you to any special exemption from yellow line restrictions, parking bays limited to 20 minutes, or parking bays reserved for Disabled Badge Holders.
- You must not assign or transfer the permit to any person. The permit must be surrendered for a refund, if you sell your property or cease to reside in the zone for which the permit has been issued. You must not sell on or pass the permit to the purchaser of your property.

Any contravention of the above will render the permit invalid and the permit will be withdrawn.

Your completed application must be accompanied by a PHOTOCOPY of all of the following documents:

- Your valid driving licence.
- A vehicle registration document or insurance certificate for the vehicle. If you have use of a vehicle but do not own it, the owner's signed consent is required.
- Proof of residency in the above zone. This should be by way of a photocopy of a tenancy agreement, Council Tax bill (current year) or a recent utility bill, for example, water, gas or electricity which should be dated within the last three months. (Please cover any financial details as we scan all the document we receive and hold them on our computer system.)

Original documents will not be accepted and a permit will not be issued if any of the documents and/or the fee is missing.

Annual Permit Cost: £75

Please contact Parking Enforcement for any other time period less than 12 months.

Please send your completed form and the correct fee (make cheques payable to Canterbury City Council) plus the necessary documents to Parking Enforcement, Canterbury City Council, Military Road, Canterbury CT1 1YW. Alternatively bring your completed form etc to the council offices in Military Road and your permit will be processed while you wait.

All permits will commence from the date of issue. **Refunds will be given for full months outstanding.**

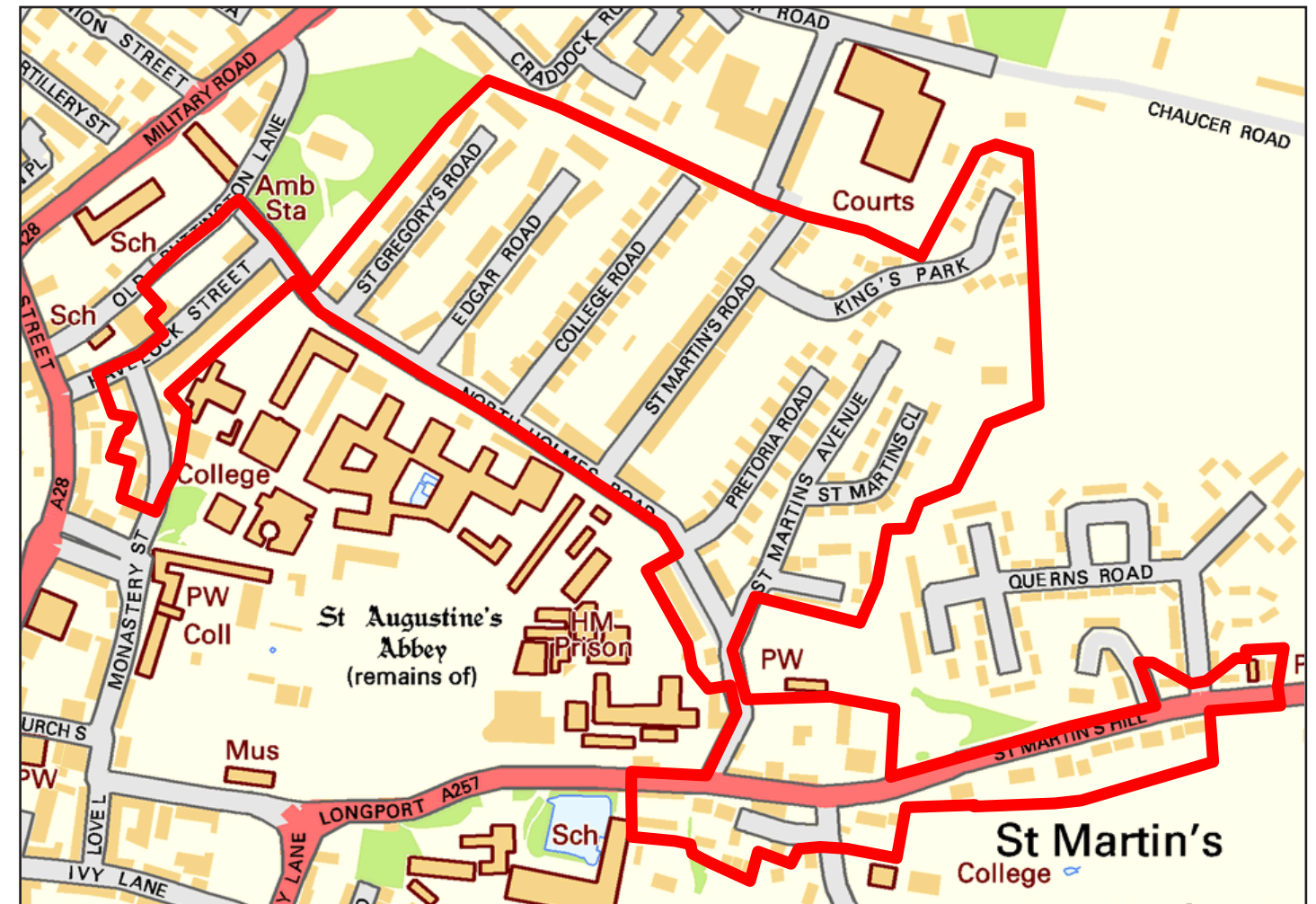
